The purpose of this letter is to relate the experience of the Quant Ci International Airport with RejuvaSeal on a porous friction coarse (FFC) asphilareatment.

The PFC was applied to 6,500 feet of the 10,000 foot primary runway at the Quad City International Airport. In the sping of 1997 a moderate amount of chips and fines were found in the dirt on the edge of the runvily. It was determined that this was the result of a combination of the natural oxidation of the aspliant and the action of the wire brooms used during snow removal operations

me summer of 1998, the entire 6,500 foot surface was treated with RejuvaSeal. Since tilt time the evidence of any loose chips or fines has been nonexistent. Therefore, I will calclude that the RejuvaSeal has extended the life of the PFC as well as solving a potential FOD problem with loose chips on the runway surface
